

USEFUL INFORMATION ON THE DOMICILE

A student accepted for ECAL's Foundation Year must pay course fees, which depends on his domicile.

A. Domicile in the Canton of Vaud

Is considered domiciled in the Canton of Vaud :

- A Swiss national or foreign student of whom at least one parent is residing in the Canton of Vaud ;
- A Swiss national or foreign student of whom both parents have deceased, but whom at least one parent was residing in the Canton of Vaud at death ;
- A Swiss national student, native of the Canton of Vaud, if both parents reside abroad, or in case of death of these, if the student lives abroad ;
- A Swiss national or foreign student permanently residing in the Canton of Vaud for two years (at the beginning of his studies) and who was gainfully employed, which allowed him a financial independance. The management of a household as well as the military service/civil service are equally considered as a gainful employment ;
- A student of age, refugee or stateless, assigned to the Canton of Vaud, if his parents reside abroad or have deceased.

In case of admission, the student must pay course fees of CHF 1'000.-.

B. Domicile in an other canton

Is considered domiciled in an other canton :

- A Swiss national or foreign student of whom at least one parent is residing in an other canton.

In case of admission, the student (or the canton of residence) must pay course fees of CHF 2'000.-.

C. Domicile abroad

Is considered domiciled abroad :

- A foreign student of whom both parents are residing abroad.

In case of admission, the student must pay course fees of CHF 4'000.-.
