Skills targeted General learning objectives	This module aims to equip students with specific skills and abilities in the field of typography and type design, by developing techniques inherent in the graphic design of letters - calligraphy, lettering, construction, digital design, scripting and the development of fonts.

In the process of creation and realisation, the student is followed in particular by one of the teachers of the module.
Forms of assessment and validation	Projects undertaken will be assessed by a jury at the end of the semester. The assessment may take students' regular attendance at classes and lectures into account. To obtain credits, students must obtain an average mark of at least 4.
Remedial teaching	Remediation is possible by working to make good observed shortfalls. Module repeated in the academic year following a fail mark, according to procedures to be agreed with the director of the module. No remediation possible after repeating the module.
