Particular importance is attached to the richness of proposals and mature reflection.</p> <p>It encourages students to be aware of the role of product creation in the contemporary design context and of continuous reappraisal in connection with new technologies and manufacturing processes.</p>
Teaching content and form	<p>This module consists of practical work to create a product or a range of products based on high-level technical and technological concepts. Students carry out compulsory and freely chosen exercises in product design as part of medium and long-term projects.</p>
Forms of assessment and validation	<p>Projects undertaken will be assessed by a panel at the end of the semester.</p> <p>The assessment may take students' regular attendance at classes and lectures into account.</p> <p>To obtain credits, students must obtain an average mark of at least 4.</p>
Remedial teaching	<p>Remediation is possible by working to make good observed shortfalls.</p> <p>Module repeated in the academic year following a fail mark, according to procedures to be agreed with the director of the module.</p> <p>No remediation possible after repeating the module.</p>
